Course Description and Level

Korean 0500 aims to enable students to communicate in Korean with functional grammatical accuracy and socio-linguistic appropriateness on various subjects and to become an independent language learner beyond classroom setting. This course expands listening and reading skills with slightly more emphasis on speaking and writing skills. Class topics include food and life, MZ generation and snack culture, troubles and concerns, Korean language in the world, etc. Upon completion of the course, students are expected to obtain the Intermediate High level of proficiency based on the ACTFL (American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages) proficiency scale.

Pre-requisite: Completion of KORN 0400/0420 or equivalent proficiency, as demonstrated by the Korean Language Placement Test
