Course Description and Level

This course is an introductory course to Korean language and culture for students with little or no previous knowledge of Korean. In this class, students learn how to engage in everyday conversations on familiar topics using key expressions, basic structures, and essential cultural knowledge in Korean, focusing on all four languages skills: speaking, listening, writing and reading. Topics include Hangul (Korean alphabet), self-introduction/greetings, telling time, daily and weekly activities and routines, past experiences, and future plans. Cultural topics are also covered to develop students' intercultural competence. Upon completion of the course, students are expected to obtain the Novice High level of proficiency based on the ACTFL (American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages) proficiency scale.

Weekly Schedule and typical workload

The weekly schedule and typical workload are as follows:
