Course Description and Level: This course aims to develop a deeper understanding of Korean society, culture, and history, through the critical reading of selected authentic texts from the early 1900s to the 1990s. Upon completion of this course, students will achieve proficiency at Advanced High Level according to the ACTFL proficiency scale. Students will be able to comprehend and produce extended texts on unfamiliar and abstract topics, and interchange opinions utilizing expressions and concepts frequently used in academic and professional settings.

Mondays	3 hrs	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Class time will be devoted to lecture, discussion on the weekly topic, and short creative writing practices.
Wednesdays- Tuesdays	3 hrs	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Read the assigned readings and leave comments on Perusall, and upload an analytical essay on Canvas before class.Each student will be required to prepare two to three 30-minute presentations on the assigned short stories throughout the semester.
