

This Special Topics Course covers feminist, queer, and Indigenous approaches to philosophy of science. We'll co-create the list of topics and readings together in the course, but classic topics include *the role of values in science*, *how academic science relates to other knowledge systems*, *the role of diversity in the epistemology of science*, and research that aims to *identify and eliminate gender, racial, and other biases in science*.

This is a seminar course, and thus participant driven. The goal is for students in the course to (a) contribute meaningfully to discussion and activities each week, and (b) produce an original research product, usually and academic paper.
