ペンシルバニア大学 2022 年 秋学期 日本語 1080: 上級日本語能力 I

コースの概要とレベル:

このコースは、アメリカでも毎年 12 月に行われる日本語能力試験 2 級 (N2) 以上を受験する学生のための準備コースです。よって、8 学期以上 (600 時間程度) の日本留学を含む日本語教育の経験、または同等の日本語能力を持つ学生が対象です。日本語能力試験は、1. 言語知識 - 文字・語彙・文法- (60 点)、2. 読解 (60 点)、3. 聴解 (60 点) 部門から成っています。会話力の部門はありません。このコースは、既に文法、語彙、漢字の知識をしっかりと積み上げた学生が対象です。漢字は少なくとも 800~900 字 (理想的には 1,000 字程度) が理解できる背景が必要です。クラスでは日本語能力試験ではどのような問題が出るのか問題形式を分析すると共に、勉強のポイント(どのような勉強をすればいいのか)を紹介します。

日本語能力試験について: 今年の日本語能力試験は 12 月 4 日 (日) です。試験の申し込みは、N1 は 8 月 10 日 (水) 12:00 pm (EST) から、N2 は 8 月 12 日 (金) 12:00 pm (EST) から開始され、9 月 13 日 (火) 8:00 pm (EST)、または、定員に達し次第終了します。そのため、ウェブサイト (<https://www.aatj.org/jlpt-us>) をこまめに確認し、申し込みが始まったら、なるべく早く申し込みを済ませてください。ペンシルバニア大学から一番近い試験会場は Villanova University です。

「試験は水もの」という表現があります。日本語の実力があっても、試験の形式、手順、雰囲気などに慣れず、緊張し過ぎて、試験に失敗することはありがちです。試験日までの時間が短いので、このコースの一番大きな目標は、みなさんに日本語能力試験そのものに慣れてもらうことにあります。ですから、このコースでは、何度も過去に出た試験問題を制限時間

内に受ける練習をします。それから、試験の日に体調を崩して、失敗することもありますから、健康管理もしっかりとしてください。

成績に関するポリシー (Grading policies) :

出席と授業態度 (Attendance and Participation) : 10%

It is essential that you attend all classes, actively participate in class activities, and keep up with the course work on a daily basis.

The first two times you are absent (for any reasons), your grade will not be affected. For each additional absence, your final grade will be lowered one percent. Three late arrival (over 10-minute tardiness) equal one absence. You are responsible for all material and work covered on days that you are absent. The participation grade is based on the student's active engagement in class activities and discussions. Come to classes well-prepared, and actively participate in the classroom activities using Japanese.

Use of cell phones, laptops, and other electronic devices in classes without your instructor's permission, is not allowed. Unsanctioned use of these devices will negatively affect your participation grade. If you must use or do it, please ask your instructor.

クイズ (Quiz) : 15%

All quizzes are given during the class. If you are late for class, you will automatically lose your time for the quiz or will not be able to take the quiz if you are late beyond the allotted quiz period. See the weekly schedule on Canvas for more details.

If you miss quizzes, you are allowed to take ONE make-up quiz. If you arrange the make-up quiz with your instructor prior to each quiz date, there will be no penalty. 10% deduction will be applied if make-up is without prior arrangement. Make-up quiz must be taken within three days after the quiz day. Your lowest score will be automatically dropped and not counted toward your final records.

JLPT 練習問題 (JLPT Practice Exam) : 20%

There will be JLPT six practice exams as weekend assignments to adjust to the JLPT format, and find strong and weak areas of your Japanese skills. It will NOT help you if you ignore time limits or copy the answer keys. All JLPT practice exams must be submitted by their due date at the beginning of the class. See the weekly schedule on Canvas for more details. Each submission count as 1 point. If your submission is the past due date, it is considered late. Then, you will receive half credit. Any assignment overdue more than one day late will receive zero point.

宿題 (Homework) : 20%

All assignments must be submitted by their due date at the beginning of the class. See the weekly schedule on Canvas for more details. Homework will be tailored to individual depending on students' language level and needs. Some examples of individually tailored homework are worksheets, short essays, reading short articles, and discussions on Canvas. Each submission count as 1 point. If your submission is the past due date, it is considered late. Then, you will receive half credit. Any assignment overdue more than one day late will receive zero point. The quality of your work is also evaluated.

プログレスチェックテスト (Progress Check Test) : 20%

All progress check tests are given in the classroom. See the weekly schedule on Canvas for more details. You are allowed to take ONE make-up progress check test. If you arrange the make-up progress check test with your instructor prior to each quiz date, there will be no penalty. 10% deduction will be applied if make-up is without prior arrangement. Make-up progress check test must be taken within three days after the quiz day.

期末 JLPT 模擬試験 (Final JLPT Practice Exam) : 15%

The final JLPT practice exam is given in the classroom. See the weekly schedule on Canvas for more details. Attendance at the final exam is mandatory. If you have a legitimate conflict, you must provide official documentation to take a make-up exam. More details will be announced.

Expectations of students

It is essential that you check the schedule and keep up with the course work on daily basis.

Approximately 8-10 hours per week including in-person classes.

Mon: In-Person Class (1.5hr)

Tue: Individual tailored assignment (1hr) and preparation for the class on Wed (1hr)

Wed: In-Person Class (1.5hr)

Thu-Sun: JLPT practice exam (3.5hr) and preparation for the quiz on Monday (1hr)

Japanese is the official language in this course. Let us immerse ourselves into Japanese. Please do not speak in English at the class without permission of your instructor. If you would like to ask questions in English, please do so after class.

Practice what is considered appropriate in Japan. Behave in a way that Japanese people would find comfortable, (not in a way that is comfortable for you.) No eating or chewing gum is allowed during the class. It interferes with a performance-based class, also this is a very common classroom policy in Japan.

Do not take it personally when corrected. Being corrected is one of the best ways to learn to speak. In fact, you must get used to being corrected all the time.
