This course analyzes the making of a modern Jewish state in the land of Israel/Palestine and the role of Zionism, Palestinian nationalism, and global politics in that process. Beginning in 19th-century Europe and the Middle East, we will study the ideas, movements, and people that shaped what has come to be known as the Arab-Israeli conflict. Students will explore the impact of international factors on the struggles that resulted from the Zionist project in Israel/Palestine and Arab reactions to it across three periods: imperialism and world wars (1860s-1940s), cold war (late 1940s-1990), and multi-polarity (1990s-present).

REQUIREMENTS:

Each week students will attend two lectures. If you cannot attend a lecture, it is your responsibility to find out what you missed. Please complete the assigned readings as early in the week as possible – you will get more out of the lectures that way. This means allowing yourself sufficient time not just to read but to think about what you've read. We are happy to take questions during lectures.

Students will submit one short paper (Week 5), take an in-class midterm (Week 8), submit a longer paper (Week 16), and take an in-class final exam during finals period. Paper advisories, with guidance for what is expected, will be distributed after the course is underway.
